

Home-school agreement for adhering to Budehaven Community School's behaviour expectations and Covid-19 regulations during the summer term 2020

We are working in very challenging conditions, with a limited amount of staff and other resources available. Staff have worked incredibly hard to provide a safe and purposeful learning environment for Year 10 pupils who have requested a place in school, and the children of Key Workers, vulnerable and Disadvantaged children. It is important that you and your child both agree to follow our rules, and that you accept that any serious breach of the behaviour expectations and Covid-19 prevention regulations will result in you being expected to collect your child from school/agree to them being sent home with immediate effect. We have no flexibility within our restricted provision to provide alternative classrooms, alternative supervision or provisions such as the Ready to Learn room.

**School**

**The school will do its best to:**

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection and Local Authority Risk assessment.
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can.
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19.
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' test positive for COVID-19.
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy where applicable, as well the expectations outlines in this agreement.
- Communicate between home and school through Schoolcomms, Facebook and the school website.

**Parent/Carer**

**To help my child at school, and to support the school, I know and understand that:**

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone.
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately. I will arrange for them to be tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone.
- On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules.
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child.
- My child will bring in their own stationery to school, and will keep this with them at all times. They will take this home with them at the end of each day they are in school, and I agree to reinforce with them that they are not to share any equipment, under any circumstance.
- I will not be allowed into the school without a pre-arranged appointment. I will make appointments via telephone or email.
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this time.
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home.
- I will inform the school of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details.
- I will follow social distancing rules at all times, and understand if there is evidence that I have not followed social distancing, my child may lose their place at school.
- If my child is deemed unsafe, or if they are behaving in a way that will cause staff to be removed from their allocated duty, or if they are, as a result, unable to supervise the children assigned to them, he/she will be

sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe. I understand that this will be considered on a case by case basis, and any decisions are at the discretion of the Headteacher.

### **Student**

#### **I will:**

- Be respectful to staff and other pupils at all times. I will be polite, well-mannered, and respect the fact that all adults in school are supporting me.
- Follow the Bubble rules that keep me safe. I will remain at the desk I am assigned to, at all times, during my learning.
- Wash my hands as soon as I go into school using the facilities I am directed to use.
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell, immediately.
- Only bring in my equipment from home, and keep it to myself at all times. I will not borrow any equipment from my peers, and I will not lend them any equipment. At this time I understand that sharing equipment, food or anything else is not allowed.
- Respect the 2m distancing rule at all times.
- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated entrance.
- Not wander around the school.
- Alert a member of staff if I am anxious, and I trust all adults to deal with any issues, as they are trained professionals.
- Follow the catch it-bin it-kill it rules coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue, which I will then dispose.
- Regularly wash my hands using soap and water for 20 seconds minimum.
- Follow the rules at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others.
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
