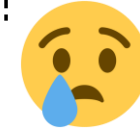
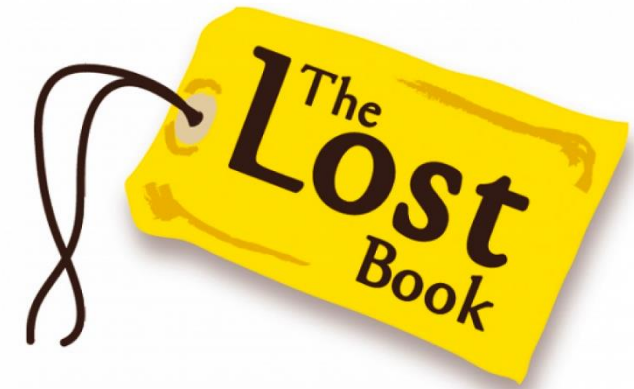


## Budehaven Library

- Amnesty for Overdue Books

- During the lockdown students were unable to return school Library books. Now we have a returns system, set up through Tutor groups, we would like overdue library books returned please, our shelves are looking a little empty!



- As so many of them are overdue, this half term, we will be having a book amnesty. There will be no charging for overdue/lost books. However, after the October half term charges for books will be made. **Charging will only be incurred for books which are lost/damaged and are unable to be returned to the library, we are not enforcing weekly charges for overdue books.**
- We will email Parents/Carers individually to let you know of any overdue books your children may have before half term. After half term set charges will be £6.99 for a fiction book and £8.99 for a non-fiction book (These prices are set by the School Library Association). We will accept a replacement book if you have one that is similar to the overdue/lost book and which is in good condition.

## Click and collect service through tutors for years 7-11



### How can I take a book out from the Library?

At the moment the Library is part of the sixth form bubble, so the rest of the school are unable to physically access the Library.

However, you will still be able to take books out, and return books.



You will be able to return books at Tutor time. Your Tutor will have a box, in their room, marked Library returns. Just pop your books in there and it will be collected, once a week, by a Librarian.
