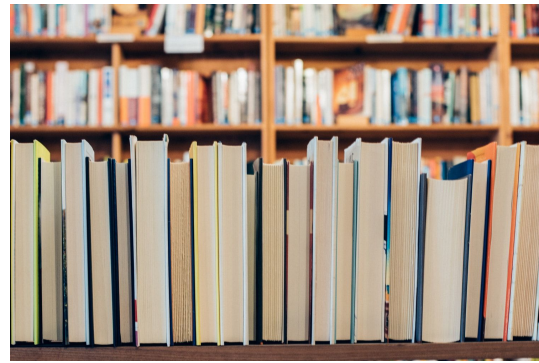

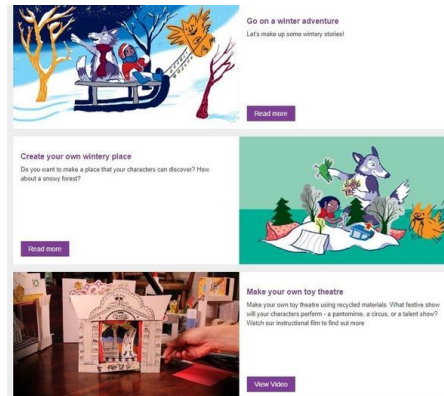
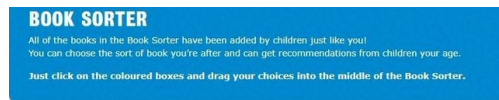
## Did you know that the Budehaven Library has its own Facebook Page?

We regularly post links to sites which would help with reading and reading resources, these are particularly helpful during this lockdown when getting reading material is difficult.

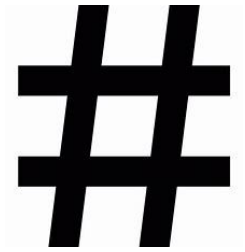
We also run a fun fact of the week as well as word of the week to keep '...the little grey cells working.'

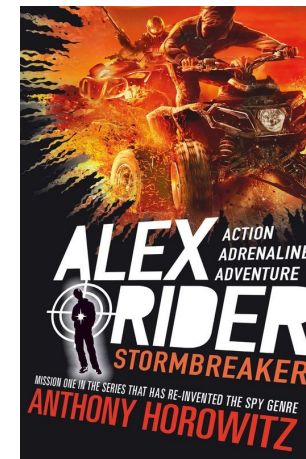
**Title: Alex Rider: Stormbreaker**
